

FUN FACTS: SHARPSBURGH:

The turn of the century found police **ORDINANCES** in Sharpsburg vigorously enforced. It is interesting to note outmoded laws that have never been repealed.

THEREFORE if a present day citizen comes upon a group of men and boys collected about the borough in a drunkenly, noisy, disorderly manner, or for the purpose of **SERENADING** in an unbecoming manner, one can evoke a citizen's arrest of ordinance July 2, 1872 that would result in the offender paying a fine of not less than five, nor more than 10 dollars.

And citizens of Sharpsburg beware that you observe **Section 7, 1872 Ordinance**, that any person who shall publicly bathe, wash, or swim naked within the borough between sunrise and **HALF PAST EIGHT** in the evening shall be liable to a fine of not less than 5, nor more than 10 dollars.

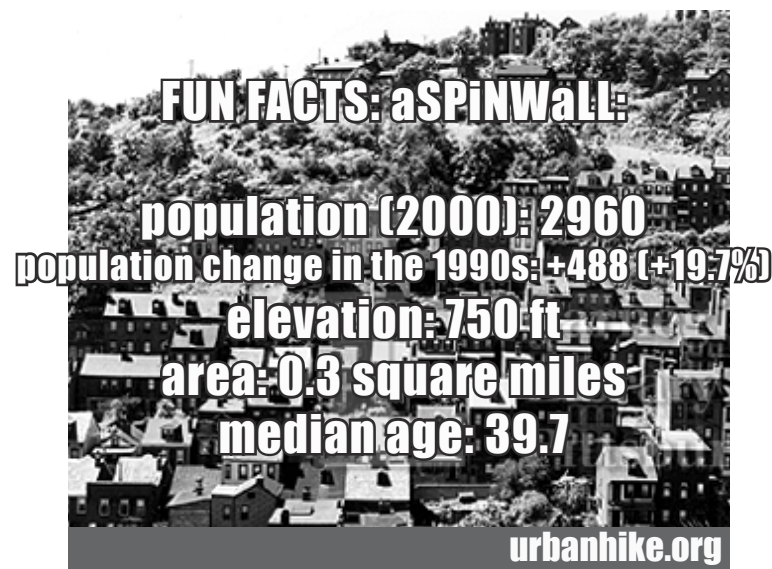

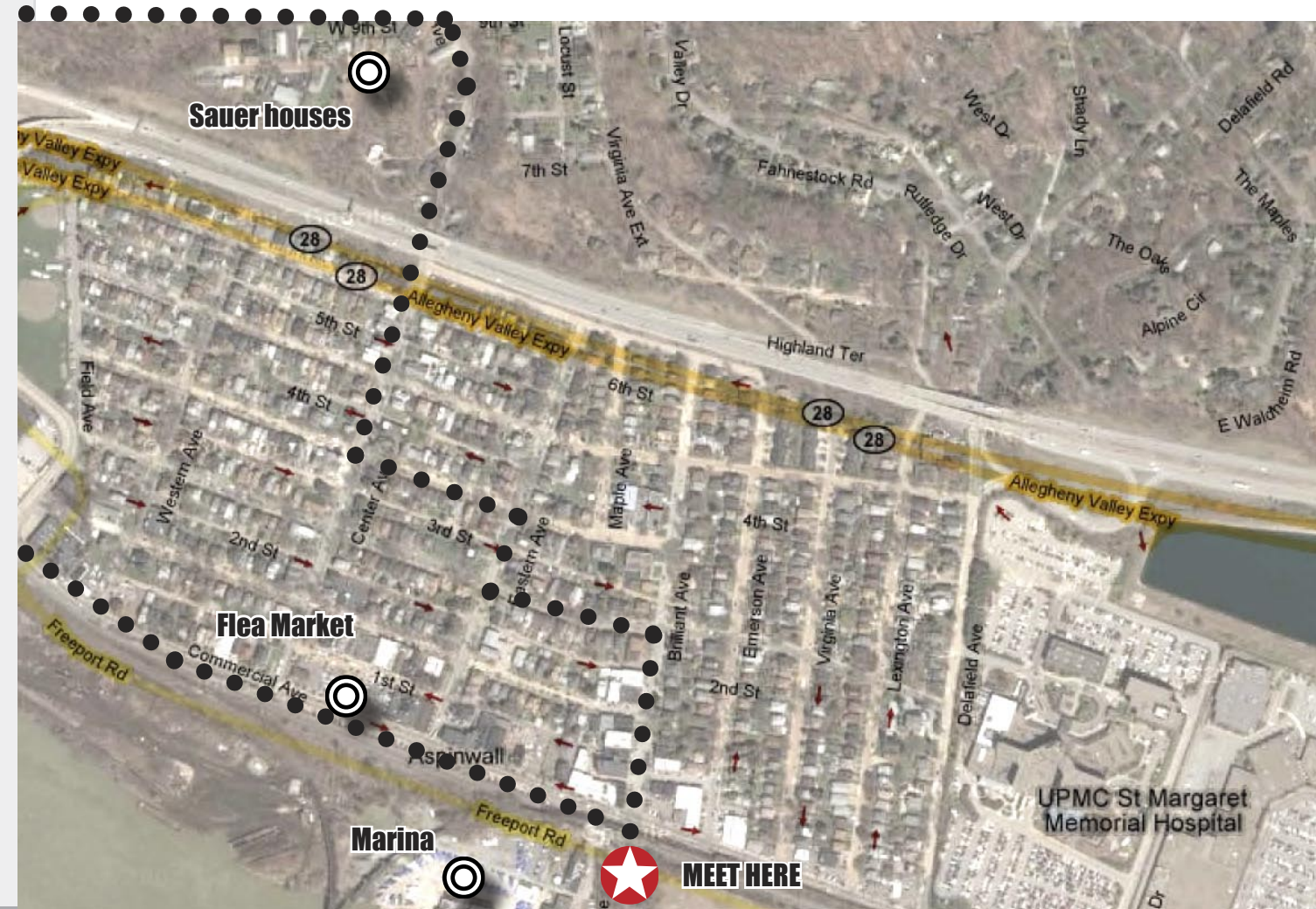
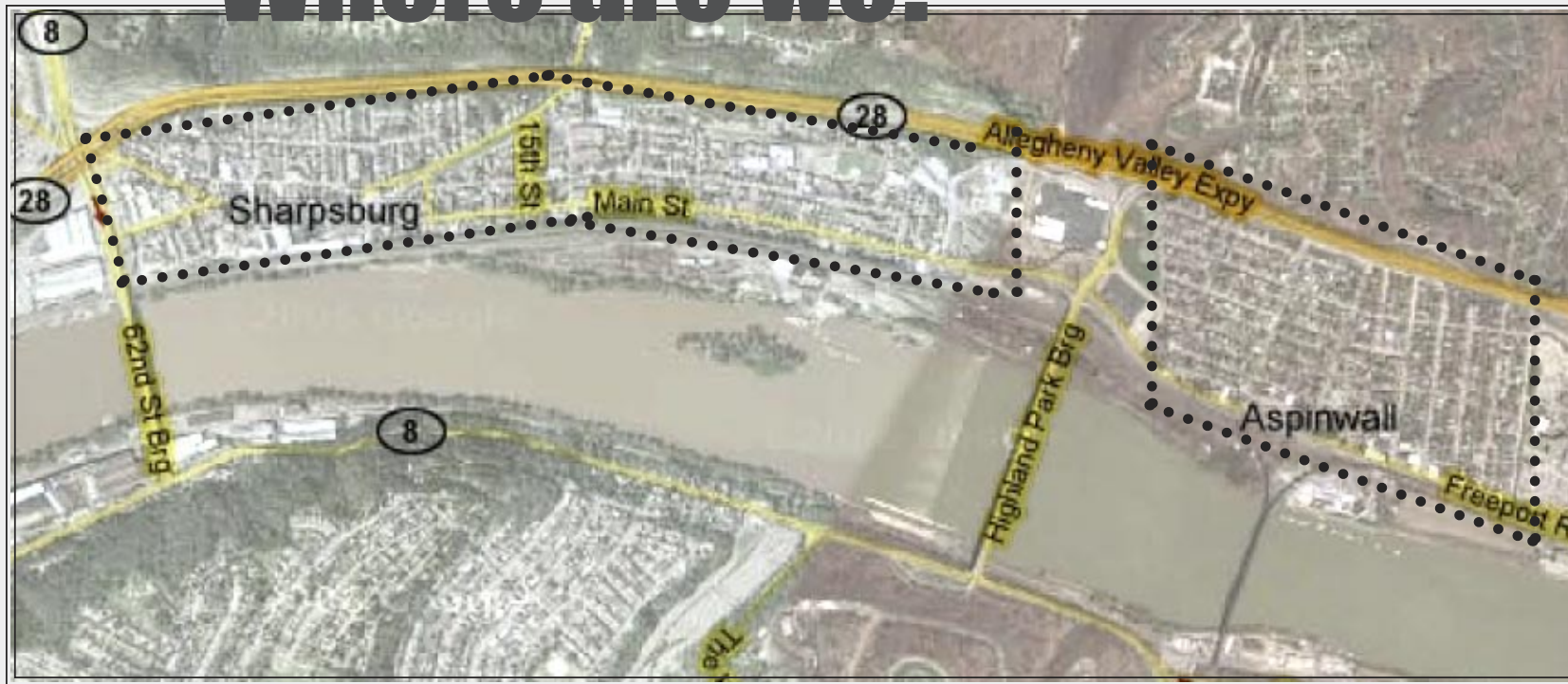
